BFD Regular Final Minutes 8/20/2024

Call to Order: 5:03 p.m.

Roll Call: President Van Walraven, Treasurer Young, Board Member Foster, Board Member Williams, HR Director Thomas, Chief Thompson, Finance Director Thompson, Deputy Chief of Opera ons Cornelius, Execu ve Assistant Diamond.

Approval of July 16, 2024 minutes: Board Member Williams mo oned to accept the minutes of July 16, 2024. Board Member Foster seconded the mo on; with the correction of Foster's name, all Board Members were in favor and non-opposed, accepting the meeting minutes from July 16, 2024.

Chief's Report: Chief Thompson told the Board he no longer thinks we need monthly mee ngs as the preconstruc on phase of Sta on 42 is ending. Chief Thompson offered to share the construc on meline with the Board so they can see where we are, and if needed, we can schedule a special mee ng. Finance Director Thompson advised they will need to meet in September for the preliminary budget, October for the first reading of the budget, and the first week in December for the second reading of the budget. President Van Walraven said they would table the discussion regarding the mee ng schedule un I January 2025.

Chief Thompson told the Board that the governor called for another special session. Chief Thompson reminded them that this would be the same process we did last year and that we would have to wait up la er the election to see our income.

Chief Thompson told the Board that last year's budget commi ee was successful and would like to see it happen again.

Chief Thompson explained the meline for construcing the maintenance building, beginning in September/October. Chief Thompson said we may need to move Stallon 42 administral on to another local on due to construction noise. Treasurer Young asked if the fence out back was finished. Chief Thompson said no the fence is not complete there are only posts on the west side they will finish our fence when the elk fence comes down.

Chief Thompson told the Board that Sta on 43 received new garage doors today.

Finance: Finance Director Thompson reviewed the bond expenditures this year. Finance Director Thompson said this was all coming out of the non-taxable funds. Finance Director Thompson told the Board we've spent three million on the property, but because we switched those accounts to the Colorado Trust in a higher interest account, we are sall geang 5.45% interest. Finance Director Thompson said we had gained \$600,000 in interest. Treasurer Young asked if we budgeted the interest income at a lower income. Finance Director Thompson explained that the bond is a new budget as of this year, so a new supplemental budget will be created, so the interest has yet to be budgeted.

President Van Walraven asked if we are up to date paying all our construc on fees. Finance Director Thompson said yes. Chief Thompson added that the preconstruc on was a set amount with Golden, but regarding Wember billing, since we switched owner reps, they did not know it was a set amount, so

Chief Thompson is nego a ng with Wember to set a budget price vs. an hourly rate. Chief Thompson hopes to have it by Friday and be provided a contract.

HR: Chief Thompson told the Board we hired a Division Chief of EMS, Aaron Lu rell.

HR Director Thomas told the Board that the Volunteer Board will revitalize its membership guidelines in September. HR Director Thomas advised they are ac vely recruing volunteers. HR Director Thomas said we will also be posing for partime posions and could have up to 20 new people staring in October. HR Director Thomas said they are having a combined academy with the volunteers and new partime employees.

Board member Comments: President Van Walraven reminded the Board that the SDA conference in Keystone is coming up on September 10-12. President Van Walraven told the Board he a ended the classes virtually last year. President Van Walraven told the Board to let Secretary Diamond know if anyone is interested in a ending and that she will help register them.

Old Business: Board Member Williams asked how Na onal Night Out turned out. Chief Thompson said it was hot, and we ran out of drinks, the boy scouts of America helped cook, and there was a good crowd. Chief Thompson said it rained and lightning for the Wednesday concert with the Wild Fire Collabora ve, but the collabora ve did make some money.
